Figure 1 | Schematic representation of the experimental design. The study was divided into two phases: a pre-test phase and a main test phase. In the pre-test phase, participants were familiarized with the task and the equipment. In the main test phase, participants performed three trials at each speed-accuracy condition (slow, medium, fast) and each load condition (light, medium, heavy). The results of the pre-test phase were used to determine the range of speeds and loads for the main test phase.
